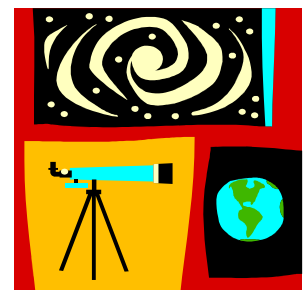

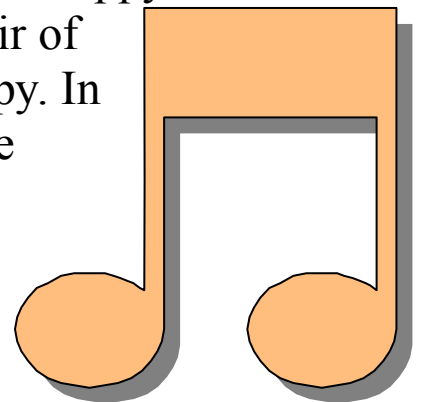


Anna's Favorite Music
